**The AACP Bylaws regarding membership classifications were amended
at the 2003 Convention to read as set out below:**

**ARTICLE III
ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP**

Section 1:

The membership of this association shall be classified as follows, and the Executive Board shall resolve any dispute concerning membership classifications or eligibility in this Association:

(A) VOTING MEMBERS – Members of the Association who shall have the privilege of voting at general membership meetings concerning the amendment of these bylaws or concerning any other Association issue where such vote is required, as defined herein, shall be classified as follows:

(1) Active Members - The following persons shall be eligible for Active Member status and shall be eligible to hold elective office:

a. Chief Administrators of any state, municipal or state university law enforcement agency having actual supervision of and receiving salaries from any legally constituted governmental jurisdiction.

b. Assistant Chief Administrators of any federal, state, municipal or state university law enforcement agency or personnel who have been designated by the Chief Administrator to carry on the duties of the Chief Administrator during their absence.

(2) Retired Members - Any Chief (as defined in Article III, Section 1 (A)(1) a. above) who has held the Active Member status in the Arkansas Association of Chiefs of Police and who has retired from active law enforcement with one of the three retirement plans and is drawing a retirement check is entitled to the same privileges and voting rights as an Active Member.

(3) Life Members – A Retired member may petition the Executive Board for Life Member status, or be nominated for such to the Executive Board by one or more voting members. The Executive Board shall consider the contribution made by the member to law enforcement, and to the Association, in determination of Life Member status. A Life Member shall have all rights and privileges of a Retired member as defined herein, but shall be exempt from the payment of dues. The Life Member status shall be voided should the member become re-employed in a capacity that would otherwise qualify them for Active Member status.

(B) NON-VOTING MEMBERS - Members of the Association who shall not have the privilege of voting or holding elective office shall be classified as follows:

(1) Professional Member - The following persons shall be eligible for Professional Member status:

a. Persons in an executive, managerial, supervisory or charge position who is responsible for the security function of a federal, corporate, business, transportation, utility, financial institution, hospital, school, or private college entity.

b. Administrators and Assistant Chief Administrators of national, state, or municipal criminal justice agencies providing direct support to law enforcement within the state of Arkansas.

(2) Supporting Member - Persons who are supportive of the purposes and objectives of the Arkansas Association of Chiefs of Police.

(3) Corporate Member - Any corporation or business that is supportive of the purposes and objectives of the Arkansas Association of Chiefs of Police.

(4) Honorary Member – The Executive Board may entertain and approve nominations from Voting Members for persons who are supportive of the Association and law enforcement to Honorary Member status. An Honorary Member shall be exempt from the payment of dues.
